Roman Sorokin: Calgary's Beatles Cover Artist

Please Introduce yourself and who you are.

My name is Roman and I am currently the Community Relations Coordinator for the Northern Hills Community Association. In my spare time I love to workout, hang out with friends, and make

music covers! It is particularly my love for making song covers that I want to focus on in this article. One such band that I have been making many covers for with my father has been the Beatles-which we started in 2010. The past 11 years have been nothing short of progress and hard work, with my father and I learning a lot about music writing, recording, and production along the way.

How did you come to play Beatles music and other music-what has been your inspiration?

It was the fall of 2009, and I had recently gotten out of my heavy metal phase (yep, I was that kind of tween). Back then, I had a love for music rhythm video games like Guitar Hero and Rock Band. By chance, it just so turned out that a Beatles: Rock Band was coming out on September 9th. Suddenly, I was intrigued and asked my dad to purchase it. This would be the turning point as this was the beginning of my first of many Beatles phases; I loved playing every single song on there and even got my dad to get the Beatles CD Box Set that came out around the same

time. By the summer of 2010, I ended up becoming very familiar with Beatles music. In fact, so much so that I had the desire to record every single recorded Beatles song with my father from their first album *Please Please Me* in 1963 to the *Past Masters* album full of their singles that came out in 1988. At first, he looked at me funny and thought that this was too crazy of a project. Nonetheless, he was on board and we started recording the first album *Please Please Me*. The result was one that sounded very amateur, but it was an important steppingstone that got the ball rolling for us for the next decade to come. We managed to complete the recording of 6 albums within 4 years, an impressive accomplishment considering the steep learning curve. However, high school would come and then university and finding time to record with my father was increasingly difficult. As a result, our release of cover albums slowed down, so much so that after the summer of 2018, we ended up taking a hiatus from recording Beatles covers. And then, the funniest thing happened...

It was November 2020, and the second wave of COVID-19 hit Alberta badly. So much so, that almost all original restrictions were brought back to contain it. With everything closing down and once again social gatherings being banned, the one remaining thing I could do was get back on doing music covers. For the next two months, after work, my dad and I would go to our basement mini studio and record for a couple of hours. The speed that we were able to record at was unparalleled to our previous experiences; we were able to complete the recording of 17 songs within the timeframe of 2 months. Not only that, but the quality that we recorded at was also unmatched to our previous records. After a couple more weeks of production, we were finally able to release the album to our family and friends in February of this year.

The experience of recording with my dad allowed the time of quarantine to pass by quicker. By the time we were done recording, mixing, and producing the album, the second wave was dying down and restrictions were easing. It really made me appreciate how important time with family is and also the value of doing what you love despite all obstacles and challenges along the way. Pandan Pizzelle Recipe Winner: **Deeana Eli**

(Makes ~16-18 crepes)

- 1 cup rice flour/ or all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 2.5 tbsp sugar
- 2 tbsp butter
- -100mL coconut milk
- 1/8 tsp salt
- 2 large eggs
- Pizzelle Maker (Can be purchased at Lina's Italian Market in Calgary)



Optional: Pandan drops (3-4 drops - based on preference)

- Toasted black sesame seeds
- Ice cream
- Nuts (Cashews,
- Almonds based on preference)



- 1) On stove top, heat coconut milk and butter until warm and bring to slight boil remove from heat immediately and let cool down.
- 2) Whisk eggs and sugar together until well blended
- 3) Dry ingredients à Mix flour, baking powder, and salt together gently with whisk.
- 4) Sift dry ingredients with strainer and slowly add to wet mixture containing eggs + sugar. Continue whisking until well blended. Batter will be loose in consistency.
- 5) Pour coconut milk and melted butter into batter and continue whisking until blended and no visible large chunks.
- 6) Add in 4 pandan drops and add 3 tbsp sesame seeds (adjust to preference).
- 7) Pour batter into 1 tbsp and pour over the cast iron pan evenly to form a thin layer.
- 6) Follow pizzelle maker instructions and wait for indicator light to shut off before removing from pan.
- 7) Remove each pizzelle crepe slowly and place on plate to cool. Serve with ice cream or nuts. Enjoy!







Waste and Recycling

How to figure out which plastics are recyclable

Do you stare at your empty plastics wondering if it belongs in the blue cart? Ask yourself this question to be sure you recycle your plastics right.

Is it a container?

If your plastic is a container like a bottle, jug, or tub, it can be recycled. Make sure it's empty, clean and dry. If it's not a container, it is not accepted in the blue cart. There may be other disposal options for your item – check <u>calgary.ca/whatgoeswhere</u>.

Be aware of these exceptions:

- Bundle your clean, stretchy plastic wrap, bubble wrap and other plastic film into a single plastic bag and tie closed for the blue cart.
- Foam packaging (polystyrene, EPE, EPS, Styrofoam) including foam marked with the recycle symbol belongs in your black cart as garbage.
- Recycle plastic lids larger than the size of your palm in the blue cart. If it's smaller, it goes in the black cart.

- Your risk of serious illness will be much lower.
- The risk of other people catching the virus from you is likely very low.
- It is likely you will have very good protection against infection, including against most current variants of concern.

The Starry Night



According to online sources, Van Gogh made this painting in 1889. It is perhaps one of Van Gogh's most recognizable work. When Van Gogh was at an institute for health reasons, he looked out the window and had a view of a beautiful starry night, then he had the idea to paint it. I love this painting because of its swirls, colors and stars. In the background are the hills and in the foreground are the houses and a tree. Wheatfield with Crows






